<b>Admissions</b>	Be part of a great team that greets festival patrons. Sell and take tickets for the event, and provide general information/directions.
<b>Bartender Support</b>	Aid main bartender in serving drinks and maintaining supplies. Must be over 19 years of age.
<b>Beverage Ticket Sales</b>	Sell vouchers for the refreshments in the Ceilidh Tent. Must be over 19 years of age.
<b>Children's Activities and Light Events</b>	Kids have a blast trying out pint sized versions of the events that they watch the Heavies do. Help with crafts in the creativity centre, or be a course marshal for mini-golfers!
<b>Entertainment &amp; Workshop Support</b>	Assist performers backstage, and help ensure the programs stay on schedule. Help with distributing and collecting materials and evaluation forms for the workshops.
<b>Exit Surveys</b>	Help us to gather information to maintain and improve the quality of the festival. This job is great for someone who likes meet and talk to people as they interview visitors to the games to complete a short survey.
<b>Heavy Events Support</b>	Scorekeeping, equipment handling and crowd control. Anyone moving equipment must have strong arms and a strong back.
<b>Highland Dancing</b>	Assist the dancers to ensure the competitions run smoothly, and on time. Assist with record and score keeping, and posting of results.
<b>Hospitality</b>	Many judges are required for the various competitions and the Friends of the Games, Sponsors, dignitaries and performers always appreciate a little extra care.
<b>Information Booth/Merchandise Sales</b>	Be part of a team that answers questions and provides information about the festival's schedule, location of events, and festival activities. Sell festival souvenirs and merchandise.
<b>Pipe Band Support</b>	Volunteers help the pipe bands run smoothly by helping with registrations and posting results and providing support to the judges and stewards.
<b>Site</b>	Keep the site in working order, solving problems as they come up. Keeping facilities tidy and moving equipment to where it is needed. Requires a strong back.
<b>Site Set-Up/Tear-Down</b>	Help build the festival village! There are tasks suited to everyone from helping put up small signs, to helping put up tents. Anytime from Wednesday morning on, help is greatly needed and appreciated.
